Appendix 3 to the Guidelines for Visitors to the Kortosfera Center for the Popularization of Science and Innovation of the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn

Rules of the High Energy Laboratory and Safety Regulations During Laboratory Presentations

The High Energy Laboratory operates high-voltage electrical equipment. All participants will observe the following rules during laboratory presentations:

- 1. These rules specify the code of conduct in the High Energy Laboratory of the Kortosfera Center for the Popularization of Science and Innovation (hereinafter referred to as Kortosfera).
- 2. The participants must exercise caution and act responsibly during presentations.
- 3. The participants must follow warning signs and safety symbols in the laboratory.
- 4. The participants must closely follow the instructions of the educator conducting the presentation.
- 5. All laboratory equipment should be regarded as potentially dangerous to health.
- 6. Laboratory equipment, instruments, and objects many not be removed from the indicated place.
- Laboratory equipment may be operated solely by the educator conducting the presentation. The participants may not touch, switch on, or operate laboratory equipment without the educator's explicit permission.
- 8. The participants will be held liable for any damage caused to laboratory equipment.
- 9. Any accidents or problems must be immediately reported to the educator conducting the presentation.
- 10. Injuries, cuts, burns, intoxication, weakness, dizziness, and confusion must be immediately reported to the educator conducting the presentation.
- 11. Eating, drinking, and smoking tobacco or e-cigarettes is strictly prohibited in the laboratory.
- 12. Laboratory presentations involve strong electromagnetic fields, noise, and light effects, and they are not recommended for persons who are sensitive to such phenomena (in particular pregnant women, persons with medical devices, and persons with epilepsy). Sensitive persons will bear full responsibility for their decision to participate in laboratory presentations.
- 13. Participants aged 7 to 12 years must be accompanied by an adult guardian. The adult guardian must buy a ticket.

- 14. Participants who leave the laboratory during a presentation wave their right to participate in the presentation and will not be entitled to a ticket refund.
- 15. The provisions of point 14 hereinabove shall not apply if a presentation is terminated for reasons attributable to Kortosfera.

Participants who violate the Rules of the High Energy Laboratory, Work Safety and Hygiene Regulations and refuse to follow the educator's instructions will be immediately asked to leave the laboratory and will not be entitled to a ticket refund
